Scholarship Application

The Ramona Junior Fair is a non-profit 501 (c)(3) corporation that provides scholarship for outstanding 4-H, FFA, and Grange members who participate in activities and events relating to the Ramona Junior Fair. To assist you in your academic and personal advancement, the Ramona Junior Fair and its supporters will be awarding several scholarships (funds permitting and applications warranting) to qualified 4-H, FFA, and Grange students.

The applicant must be a graduating senior or have graduated in the past year and cannot have received a Ramona Junior Fair Scholarship in the past. Recipients must be members in good standing in 4-H, FFA, or Grange. These students should have exhibited in the Ramona Junior Fair for at least 2 years, and have actively contributed to the success of the fair. Each applicant must have plans to further their education by attending a two or four-year program at a college or vocational school of higher learning.

Qualified applicants are those students who have completed and submitted a complete application. Complete applications consist of: A Completed Ramona Junior Fair Scholarship Form, Three Letters of Recommendation (as listed below), and a Sealed and Stamped Official Transcript from current school.

The applicant must submit three separate letters of recommendation: **one** letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator, **one** letter of recommendation from a leader or advisor, and **one** letter of recommendation from a current or past member of The Ramona Junior Fair Board of Directors. Recommenders must complete and attach the appropriate Recommendation Form provided in this application packet even when submitting a separate letter of recommendation. Letters of recommendation and recommendation forms **must** be sent with the completed application. Applicants may not submit letters of recommendation written by family members.

Applications **must** be postmarked or received by <u>March 6, 2020.</u> Completed applications should be mailed to:

* Applications may also be delivered to the Scholarship Committee Chairman prior to the due date.

The Ramona Junior Fair Board and the Scholarship Committee reserve the right to adjust the amounts awarded or refuse the scholarship to any applicant. The decision of the Scholarship Committee shall be final. Applicants submitting incomplete applications will not be eligible for consideration for the scholarship. Applicants found ineligible will be notified by the Scholarship Chair prior to the scheduling of interviews.

Applications will be reviewed and applicants will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee by appointment Attire for the interview shall be the uniform representing the applicant's club or chapter. Record books are welcome at the interview, but in no way will affect eligibility for a scholarship.

Scholarship recipients must be present in uniform at the beginning of the Livestock Auction and are expected to be active in auction activities such as running paperwork to buyers. Monies awarded from this scholarship must be claimed no more than two calendar years after receipt.
