

# How the Online Auction Works

## **Auction Registration**

Go to the [WWW.RamonaJuniorFair.com](http://WWW.RamonaJuniorFair.com) website and go to the Auction page. Select the registration link and register as a buyer. Auction registration will be open on Thursday July 30<sup>th</sup>. **Mobile cellular phone number** is needed so you can get your security code via text message and get text message updates during the auction bidding. After registration you will be able to view all the animals and projects that are available to bid on.

## **Auction Bidding**

Auction bidding will open Friday July 31<sup>st</sup> at 10AM and will close on Saturday August 1<sup>st</sup> at 10AM. Bidding on an animal or project will be in \$25 increments. If you wish to bid on an animal or project, select the animal or project you wish to bid on. Select Make Bid button. Choose the bid amount you want to bid using \$25 increments. Example is you can bid up the minimum \$25 or you can do more such as \$50, \$75, \$100 and so on. You will also need to pick a destination for the animal when bidding. Choose one of the options. After you have bid, keep an eye on the auction page or your cell phone to know if someone has out bid you. Continue to bid as you please. The more you bid the more you support these kids for next year's projects and/or college.

## **Lot 1 in the auction will be for donating to the fair directly. Scholarships are an example of what the donation will go towards.**

**Barn Sale** You ask what is the barn sale? This is where the kids sell their other remaining animals. Normally this is done in person after the livestock auction. We will be having a barn sale for our exhibitors and for you to have a second chance to purchase a quality animal. The barn sale will start after the livestock auction on Saturday starting at 10:30AM and will run 2 hours till 12:30PM.

## **Sold!**

Congratulations, you are the winning bidder! You have just purchased an auction animal. Upon the completion of the sales transaction please indicate the disposition of the animal (how it will be hauled, where it will be slaughtered and processed) and make sure that all information is filled out completely. If need be, we will share your contact buyer information with the youth seller information to discuss any custom arrangements that are needed between the two of you. Now you have several choices to make regarding the disposition of that animal.

## **Select the Destination for the animal, Below are the options.**

State Plant – CCI ..... Swine, Sheep, Veal & Goats ..... \$70 *Fee will be added to your bill today*

State Plant- CCI ..... Beef ..... \$150 *Fee will be added to your bill today*

Prices include pick of animal at the fair, slaughter, refrigeration of carcass, delivery of carcass to your custom processor/butcher of your choice.

## **You must also select the Custom Processor/ Butcher where your meat will be cut and wrapped to your specifications**

## **Self-Haul**

You may take the animal home and arrange for slaughter and custom processing on your own. You **MUST** bring your sales slip for release of the animal on Sunday morning to pick up the animal.

## **Sell to Packer**

The original amount you paid for the animal will go to the exhibitor, but you can sell the animal back to the packer. The packer sell back price will be deducted from your RJF invoice. The animal will go to the packer and no meat will be returned to the buyer.

**Resales- No resales this year** -We will not have the traditional resale option you maybe accustomed to as we do not have this option with our online auction this year. You may purchase an animal and then select sell to the packer.

## **Payment**

**Credit, Debit, Cash & Check** are accepted. 3% Credit Card Fee. All Sales must be paid in full by 4 p.m. auction day. Credit card and E-Check payments can be made over the phone by contacting Kristy Parker at 760-522-2701 or Carol Roe at 760-644-0767. The fairgrounds office will also be open on Saturday from 1-4pm to accept in-person payments.

#### Registration Instructions:

1. Confirm your name or business is not in the drop-down list on the log in page to avoid duplicate registration.
2. Complete the buyer name (this is the name that will be displayed on the auction site), contact name, address, email, and cell phone. Make sure it is a cell phone to receive text messages. Select Register. A text message will be sent to you with your 4-digit security code.
3. Return to the login page and select your name in the drop-down list.
4. Enter your 4-digit security code that was just text to you. This security code is your bidding code for the auction, remaining the same each time you log in. You do not have to request a new code each time.
